Dear Parents and Carers

This term Year 4 have continued their learning about how to keep healthy in their Science lessons. To conclude our topic and celebrate the children's hard work this year we are going to be having a special curriculum day on **Monday 18th July**.

During the morning, the children will be designing and preparing some healthy picnic food and also some activities that promote healthy exercise. During the afternoon, we will be going on to the school field to share our picnic and take part in the physical activities that they planned. Many of the tasks for the day are part of our Skills for Life passport challenges. **This will not replace your child's school dinner/packed lunch.**

On **Tuesday 19th July**, the Year 4 GTBG reward treat will be to visit Friston Park. Any child who has not earned their GTBG reward for this term, will remain in school and will be supervised in another class.

We will be walking to Friston Park on the morning of Tuesday 19th July to spend about 30 minutes enjoying physical activities. The children will be accompanied by Warren Wood staff at all times.

The children have PE on Tuesdays and so they can wear their PE and trainers. Again, please also note that the children will be outside, so the following items will also be necessary: sun hat/cap, extra drinking water and sun cream to be applied.
