

## YEAR 3

Squirrel, Hedgehog and Cedar class.

Topic for the Term 4: The Anglo Saxons

For our 'Wow' day, we will be watching Charlie and The Chocolate factory the musical.



### English

We will be continuing to look at the Power of Reading text: Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

We are going to be using our Power of Reading text to learn the skills needed to write a newspaper report and a story.

### Maths

Children will be continuing to develop their mathematical skills looking at multiplication and division using times tables, place value and exploring lines, turns and scaling.

### Science

This term the children will be learning about light. They will be looking at reflective surfaces, making shadows and learning about sun safety.

### History

Children will be learning about the Anglo Saxons and Scots. They will look at invasions, village life and Anglo Saxon Kings and Gods.

### Geography

In Geography this term, the children will be learning about where the Anglo Saxons came from and where they invaded on a map and globe. They will also look at the different Kingdoms.

### RE

The focus this term will be on 'What is good about Good Friday?' The children will be thinking about what happened on Good Friday in the Easter story and debating on whether they believe that it was a Good Friday.

### Art and DT

This term we will be using clay to create Stone Carvings as well as making an Anglo Saxon helmets using a variety of resources.

### ICT

The children will be looking at data and information including databases. The children will be branching and structuring databases as well as presenting information.

### PSHE

This term the focus will be on working cooperatively together, being considerate, when things go wrong and our responsibilities.

### French

This term in French, the children will be looking at portraits / portrait.

## Homework

At Warren Wood Primary Academy, we believe that homework makes an important contribution to your child's learning. Homework can provide the opportunity to reinforce work completed at school or prepare for work coming up. ## Uniform / PE Kit



We would ask that all children wear appropriate uniform at all times, including house team T-shirts for PE (available to purchase through Parent Pay). If there is a particular reason why your child is not in full uniform, please email the school.

If your child is unable to participate in PE lessons on any given day, please forward us an explanation. The easiest and most convenient way to contact us is through the new class email addresses (please see below in the 'contacting the teacher' section).

Appropriate PE kit is important for safety and hygiene reasons, (black shorts, house coloured T shirt, black tracksuit and trainers or plimsolls). We will contact parents if children forget kit repeatedly. Children will not be permitted to participate in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings: these will need to be removed beforehand. **Year 3 PE days are every Tuesday and Thursday– on these days children should wear their PE kit into school, rather than bring it in separately. This term it is important to note that we are going swimming on Mondays, therefore please provide appropriate kit.**
