Topic for the Term 6: The Rainforest

For our 'Wow' day, we will be having a Rainforest day at school.



English

We will be starting a new Power of Reading text: If I ran the Rainforest

We are going to be using our Power of Reading text to learn the skills needed to write a descriptive story set inside the rainforest as well as a diary entry.

Maths

Children will be continuing to develop their mathematical skills looking at multiplication and division using times tables, place value, looking at fractions and finding the perimeter on different shapes.

Science

This term we will be revising everything we have learnt this year and focus on any gaps in our knowledge.

Geography

We are continuing to look at the rainforest, researching into the people of the Amazon. As well as the causes and effects of deforestation.

RE

The focus this term will be on how a Sikh shows commitment to God.

Art and DT

This term we will be making a 3D Rainforest in a shoe box, also creating rainforest collages.

ICT

The children will be looking at making their own program using and moving sprites.

PHSE

This term the focus will be on what it means to live in Britain and we will be looking at diverse Britain along with British values.

French

This term in French, the children will be looking at portraits / portrait.

Homework

At Warren Wood Primary Academy, we believe that homework makes an important contribution to your child's learning. Homework can provide the opportunity to reinforce work completed at school or prepare for work coming up. It gives your child the opportunity to work independently, although you should support your child and take an interest in the work they are completing.

Homework projects will be completed using MYON. Teachers will set assignments on a Friday and these will need to be completed by the Wednesday.

Children will also be taking home a list of spellings to learn and will be tested on them weekly.

English worksheet (Reading, games on Pixl app, MYON)

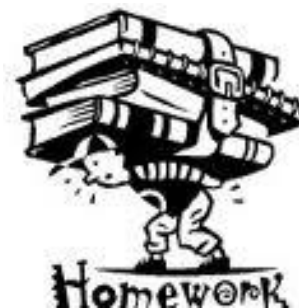
Weekly spellings

Uniform / PE Kit



We would ask that all children wear appropriate uniform at all times, including house team T-shirts for PE (available to purchase through Parent Pay). If there is a particular reason why your child is not in full uniform, please email the school.

If your child is unable to participate in PE lessons on any given day, please forward us an explanation. The easiest and most convenient way to contact us is through the new class email addresses (please see below in the 'contacting the teacher' section).

Appropriate PE kit is important for safety and hygiene reasons, (black shorts, house coloured T shirt, black tracksuit and trainers or plimsolls). We will contact parents if children forget kit repeatedly. Children will not be permitted to participate in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings: these will need to be removed beforehand. **Year 3 PE days are every Tuesday and Wednesday for Hedgehogs – on these days children should wear their PE kit into school, rather than bring it in separately. This term it is important to note that we are going swimming on Mondays, therefore please provide appropriate kit.**

PE for Squirrel class will be on Monday and Wednesday.

This term Squirrel class will be taking part in forest schools on a Tuesday.
