Squirrel, Hedgehog and Cedar class.

Topic for the Term: Stone Age to Iron Age



How do people adapt through different periods of history?

On the 9th November 2021 the children will be participating in a Stone Age day, where will have a visit from Memma the Cavewoman. Throughout the day they will be looking closely at the different tools used and be able to create comparisons to life today.

English

We will be looking at Power of Reading text:

How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth.

We are going to be using our Power of Reading text to learn the skills needed to write a recount as well as instructional writing.

Maths

Children will be continuing to develop their mathematical skills looking at multiplication, division, shape and missing numbers.

Science

This term the children will be investigating animals including humans. This involves looking at different types of skeletons and learning the name of bones. In addition, the children will be researching types of nutrition.

History

Children will be learning about the Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will be looking at the various inventions created in this time period. As well as this, they will look closely at the religions and cultures that could be found.

Geography

In Geography this term, the children will be learning about natural disasters, including: earthquakes, tsunamis and tornadoes.

RE

The focus this term will be on 'Has Christmas lost its true meaning?'

Art and DT

We will be looking at drawings of the Earth's layers and creating our own skeletons using a variety of different mediums.

ICT

The children will be looking at computing systems and networks. Investigating how a digital device works and how they help us.

PSHE

This term the focus will be on Safety First, looking at new responsibilities and different hazards/risks.

Homework

At Warren Wood Primary Academy, we believe that homework makes an important contribution to your child's learning. Homework can provide the opportunity to reinforce work completed at

school or prepare for work coming up. It gives your child the opportunity to work independently, although you should support your child and take an interest in the work they are completing.

Homework projects will be completed using MYON. Teachers will set assignments on a Friday and these will need to be completed by the Wednesday.

Children will also be taking home a list of spellings to learn and will be tested on them weekly.

English (Reading, games on Pixl app, MYON)

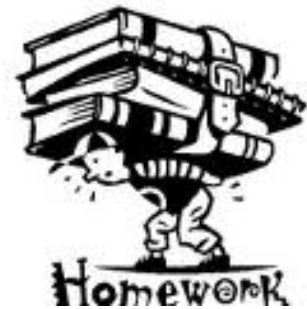
Weekly spellings

Uniform / PE Kit



We would ask that all children wear appropriate uniform at all times, including house team T-shirts for PE (available to purchase through Parent Pay). If there is a particular reason why your child is not in full uniform, please email the school.

If your child is unable to participate in PE lessons on any given day, please forward us an explanation. The easiest and most convenient way to contact us is through the new class email addresses (please see below in the 'contacting the teacher' section).

Appropriate PE kit is important for safety and hygiene reasons, (black shorts, house coloured T shirt, black tracksuit and trainers or plimsolls). We will contact parents if children forget kit repeatedly. Children will not be permitted to participate in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings: these will need to be removed beforehand. **Year 3 PE days are every Monday and Wednesday—on these days children should wear their PE kit into school, rather than bring it in separately. Monday will be outdoor PE and on Wednesday it will take place inside.**
