Squirrel, Hedgehog and Cedar class.

Topic for the Term: Chocolate.

How can we create an innovative product that our local community would enjoy?



For our 'Wow' day, we will be having a Willy Wonka's tea party with lots of taste testing and even some making of chocolate.

English

We will be looking at Power of Reading texts:

Charlie and the chocolate factory.

We are going to be using our Power of Reading text to learn the skills needed to write a persuasive letter, a diary entry and instructions.

Maths

Children will be continuing to develop their mathematical skills looking at formal methods of adding and subtracting, place value and fractions.

Science

This term the children will be investigating forces and magnets. This will include looking at how things move differently on different surfaces. The children will also look at magnets and materials that are attracted or repelled by them.

History

Children will be learning about the history of chocolate. They will be looking at various research mediums such as the internet and books. This will include looking at Fairtrade chocolate.

Geography

In Geography this term, the children will be learning about the local area. They will also research where chocolate comes from and think about the differences in the local areas.

RE

The focus this term will be on 'Could Jesus really heal people?' The children will be debating whether there were miracles or is there some other explanation.

Art and DT

We will be looking at designing our own chocolate bar including the packaging.

ICT

The children will be looking at desktop publishing and creating media. They will record and present information using a range of media combining text and graphics for a printable form or digital form and talk about the differences.

PSHE

This term the focus will be on Digital wellbeing. The children will be looking at how to stay safe on the internet and what they can do to support their own wellbeing when using digital devices.

Homework

At Warren Wood Primary Academy, we believe that homework makes an important contribution to your child's learning. Homework can provide the opportunity to reinforce work completed at school or prepare for work coming up. It gives your child the opportunity to work independently, although you should support your child and take an interest in the work they are completing.

Homework projects will be completed using MYON. Teachers will set assignments on a Friday and these will need to be completed by the Wednesday.

Children will also be taking home a list of spellings to learn and will be tested on them weekly.

English (Reading, games on Pixl app, MYON)

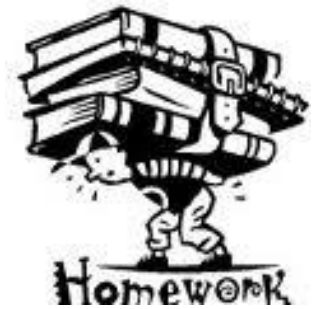
Weekly spellings

Uniform / PE Kit



We would ask that all children wear appropriate uniform at all times, including house team T-shirts for PE (available to purchase through Parent Pay). If there is a particular reason why your child is not in full uniform, please email the school.

Appropriate PE kit is important for safety and hygiene reasons, (black shorts, house coloured T shirt, black tracksuit and trainers or plimsolls). We will contact parents if children forget kit repeatedly. Children will not be permitted to participate in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings: these will need to be removed beforehand. **Year 3 PE days are every Monday and Tuesday– on these days children should wear their PE kit into school, rather than bring it in separately. This term it is important to note that we are going swimming on Mondays, therefore please provide appropriate kit.**
