

Admission to primary school September 2024

- You must apply to your home local authority (ie if you pay your council tax to Medway Council you must apply to Medway). If you pay your council tax to one of the district councils of Kent (for example, Swale or Maidstone) then you must apply to Kent County Council.
 - You can name schools in any area but you must apply to your home local authority.
 - Medway residents can apply from **9am on Monday, 4 September 2023**.
 - Please make sure that you have submitted your application by **5pm on Monday, 15 January 2024**.
 - If you do not want to apply online and would prefer to complete a paper application form, please contact the School Admissions and Transport Team.
Please note: Medway Council do not acknowledge receipt of paper applications in writing or over the phone.
