Year 5 EHCP students for transfer to secondary Sept 2025

The LA recommend that parents go and see the schools of preference as soon as they can.

Most secondary schools have open evenings Sept and October each year. This means that parents of children with EHCP's should visit secondary schools in Yr4 & 5 to get a 'feel for the school' that they would like as their preference.
